## Quarterly Management Reviews!

WSID recently re-introduced the Quarterly Management Reviews (QMRs). QMRs provide WDA-specific expenditure and enrollment information related to WIA grants and contracts. The first QMRs cover program year activity through the quarter ending December 31, 2011. One QMR is produced for each WDA and is shared with the WDC responsible for overseeing WIA activities in that specific local area. QMRs are designed to provide WSID with a vehicle for reviewing fund data in each local area, provide WDCs with the same opportunity to see what WSID is seeing and offer a local context for the numbers, and better inform decision-making at both the state and local levels.

## WorkSource System Policies

The TAES team will assume responsibility for all WSID's policy efforts going forward. With the goal of streamlining and providing value added system policies, WSID is forming a 10 to 15 member Policy Advisory Committee with representation from the functional units of our system – oversight, operations and service provision.. WSID has identified initial priorities and recommendations for the committee's consideration but intends for the Advisory Committee to serve as the primary driver of system policy revision efforts.

The following WDC Directors have agreed to serve on the committee: Steve Frazier, Gay Dubigk, Dave Peterson & Mark Mattke. WSID is communicating with other system stakeholders to solicit additional members.

Committee members will receive background information related to the policy project. WSID's goal is to maintain transparency and provide appropriate support to the Committee in its work over the next year.
