Basic Food Employment & Training

The Basic Food Employment & Training (BFET) program assists King County residents who receive food stamps with tuition, books and fees for college.

Opportunity Grant

Opportunity Grant funds tuition, fees and books for low income students enrolled in specific state-approved career paths. You must meet income eligibility guidelines to participate in this program.

WorkFirst

The WorkFirst program pays for tuition, books and fees for TANF parents who are currently receiving a cash grant from the Department of Social and Human Services. To participate in this program parents must have approval from their DSHS case manager.

Worker Retraining

Worker Retraining can help pay for training expenses for individuals that are unemployed, veterans that have received an honorable discharge and displaced homemakers. Worker Retraining helps you gain the skills and certification needed to be competitive in today's job market.
