<b>Times Used</b>	<i>Used 7 times between January 1, 2012 and March 19, 2012, last used for one seeker on 3/12/2012 in the Pacific Mountain area.</i>
<b>Use Distribution</b>	<i>This service was used 6 times in the Pacific Mountain area and only once in the Tacoma-Pierce area during the above time period.</i>
<b>Reporting</b>	<i>This service is used for Federal reporting.</i>
<b>Analysis</b>	<i>This was an official Offender Employment Services (OES) service. With the elimination of OES, this service is now rarely provided.</i>
<b>Initial Recommendation</b>	<i>The recommendation is to deactivate this service. WSID wishes to maintain a direct connection between programs and their related services. When programs have expired, all related services will be deactivated. If a similar service is still being provided throughout the state,</i>

## **Feedback to Review**

*Only one area commented that they would like to keep this service active stating, "...our area feels that the re-entry services are of value (particularly the Re-entry orientation). We have a prison system with offenders who have been in long term. We are providing the service with our partners. We'd appreciate it if the services were not turned off."*

## **Response to Feedback and Final Decision**

*Because this service was related to a program that has expired it will be deactivated.*

*Statewide services should be used in significant numbers, in a significant number of areas and that the service be delivered consistent to it's original design.*

*Areas are encouraged to create a local service if an area desires to continue to offer a "like" service.*
