SUBJECT: PY13 Self-Employment Training Demand Targets

Purpose:

To establish self-employment training targets for the WIA Adult & Dislocated Worker (DW) programs for program year 2013 in alignment with [Self-Employment Training \(SET\) Policy 3705](#).

Action Required:

WDCs are directed to use the percent of WIA Adult and Dislocated Worker program enrollees who listed self-employment as a goal to determine, for the purposes of the PY 2013 WIA planning form, the minimum number of participants that will be enrolled in WIA-funded self-employment training during PY 2013.

Content:

WIA Policy 3705 requires ESD to establish a plan for expending WIA funds on self-employment assistance training at a rate that is commensurate with either consumer demand or the rate of self-employment within the WDA.

WCDD has determined that self-employment training targets shall be based on WIA eligible individuals who have expressed an interest in self-employment training during the preceding program year with the exception of WDA 12 (see [public comment responses](#)). WCDD used the total number of Adult & Dislocated worker enrollees who listed self-employment as a goal (numerator) among the total number of WIA Adult & Dislocated Worker enrollees (denominator) as reported through SKIES during calendar year 2012. The targets per WDA, excluding WDA 12, are represented in the following table:
