**SUBJECT:** Distribution of Fiscal Year 2015 Rapid Response funds to local areas to serve additional WIA-eligible dislocated workers

**Purpose:**

To communicate the State’s decision to formula-allocate \$2 million in Fiscal Year 2015 (FY15) Rapid Response funds to bolster local area FY15 WIA Title I-B Dislocated Worker formula allotments.

**Action Required:**

Revised FY15 WIA Title I-B Dislocated Worker grant packages will soon be issued to each Workforce Development Council (WDC). Please complete the packages and return two signed copies to Donna Fussell in the Workforce and Career Development Division’s WIA Administration Unit for processing.

**Content:**

The State is bolstering local area FY15 WIA Title I-B Dislocated Worker formula allotments with \$2 million in FY15 Rapid Response funds.
