Health Occupations Core—Nursing Assistant Certified (HOCNA):



The HOCNA cluster combines HOC, CPR / First Aid and Nursing Assistant Certification with “stackable” modules of Modified Fundamentals of Care-giving and Nurse Delegation.

Students will be prepared to work in entry-level healthcare jobs in a variety of healthcare settings. Settings include acute care as well as community based agencies.

Completers will be eligible to take the state nursing assistant written and skills tests and to apply for certification as a state recognized nursing assistant.
