### Green Enterprise/Lean Manufacturing

The Principles of Lean Manufacturing (Lean 101) is an interactive introduction to the principles and methodology of lean manufacturing. The Green Enterprise Certificate Program (GECPP) program is a 52-hour program providing hands-on activities, simulations, and case studies to teach environmental sustainability that leads to process improvement. This program is designed for job seekers with some manufacturing or production background; you will learn how to apply sustainable, environmentally friendly practices in the workplace. At the end of this training, participants can earn an SME Green Manufacturing Certificate with accreditation through the Society of Manufacturing Engineers (SME) by successfully completing the exam.

### Machining Technician

**Need machining skill enhancement?**  
**Need a certificate to gain employment?**

This class helps participants to build skills necessary to gain employment in the machining industry. Students can progress independently through the skill sets and will receive a Certificate of Competency showing the skill levels they completed. In a combined lecture and lab format, this program offers instruction in numerous machine processes including set-up and operation of engine lathe, surface grinders, vertical mill, safety, precision measurements, tooling, and an introduction to CNC operation.
